### Competition Consent Form

#### Terms and conditions

1. The Promoter is the Queensland Police Service (ABN 29 409 225 509) and is a declared government entity.
2. Your submission of an entry into this competition is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.
3. Competition entry is only open to current grade three to six school students attending schools or living in the Logan Local Government Area (Queensland).
4. All entrants (person submitting the art competition entry) must have their parent/guardian's permission and their parent/guardian must sign this Competition Consent Form.
5. The competition commences at 12am on August 1, 2021 and concludes at 5pm on August 12, 2021 ("Promotional Period").
6. The submission must be completed on an A4 piece of paper or cardboard using one of the templates from this template location: <https://streetsmarts.initiatives.qld.gov.au/tools-and-resources/tagged/road-safety-week#items>
7. The submission must be completed by the child entering the competition.
8. All entrants entering this competition and their parent(s)/guardian(s) must consent to the submission being used in the promotion of road safety messaging including being displayed at the *Logan Art Centre* for public viewing and on various social media platforms.
9. All entrants and their parent(s)/guardian(s) entering this competition consent to having their photo taken with the Logan City Council Mayor for publication to promote Queensland Road Safety Week and the competition.
10. To enter the competition, submit your entry and this signed form via email to [infraplanning@logan.qld.gov.au](mailto:infraplanning@logan.qld.gov.au)
11. The Promoter holds the right to not accept entries that are not submitted in the above mentioned way.
12. Entries must be received by the Promoter by the specified closing date and time.
13. At the time of submitting your entry, you must submit this consent form, signed by yourself (the entrant) and a parent/guardian.
14. One entry per person only. The entrant submitting the content must be the creator of the content and it must not include copyright material belonging to any other party without providing written permission to use that material.
15. Entries will be deemed accepted at the time of receipt and not at the time of transmission. Incomplete, inaudible or incomprehensible entries will be deemed invalid. No responsibility will be taken for lost, late or misdirected entries.
16. Content must not contain any coarse language, nudity, violence or racial vilification.
17. Judging of entries will take place at the conclusion of the promotional period. Entries close at 5pm on August 12, 2021.
18. All judging will be conducted by a panel nominated by the competition organisers. All winners will be notified by email or phone on August 13.

19. Prize winners will be decided in three separate entrant/age categories being:

- Student entries in grades three and four,
- Student entries in grade five
- Student entries in grade six.

15. Prize allocation for each category will be:

- 1<sup>st</sup> prize: A bicycle
- 2<sup>nd</sup> prize: A bicycle tool kit
- 3<sup>rd</sup> prize: A bicycle helmet

16. The Promoter will contact winners and runners up following the completion of the competition and deliver prizes to the winner and runners up in person. Winners and runners up must present a photo ID on collection of prize.

17. If any prize is unavailable, for whatever reason, the Promoter reserves the right to substitute the prize for a prize of equal or lesser value.

18. Prizes are not redeemable for cash, credit or product and no exchanges are offered. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any variation in the value of the prize (or part thereof).

19. As a condition of accepting the prize, the winner - where applicable, must sign any legal documentation as and in the form required by the Promoter in their absolute discretion, including but not limited to a legal release and indemnity form.

20. The Promoter reserves the right to validate and check the authenticity of any prize claim or entry before awarding a prize.

21. The Promoter's decision in relation to any aspects of the competition is final and binding on every person who enters, and no correspondence will be entered into.

22. The Promoter and their associated agencies, and companies associated with this promotion will take no responsibility for prizes damaged or lost in transit.

23. In the event that for any reason whatsoever a winner does not take an element of the prize at the time stipulated by the promoter, then that element of the prize will be forfeited by the winner and cash will not be awarded in lieu of that element of the prize.

The Promoter's legal rights to recover damages or other compensation from such an offender are reserved.

27. All entries become the property of the Promoter. As such, the Promoter is the owner of all copyright and other intellectual property in the winning responses.

28. The Promoter collects personal information to facilitate awarding of prizes. No personal details will be sold or provided to external parties not involved in the program. To facilitate your participation, the Promoter may disclose your personal information to other companies associated with this promotion. If you do not provide your personal information, the Promoter will not be able to enter you into this promotion.

29. The Promoter reserves the right to use any entry for promotional/media purposes.

30. If for any reason this promotion is not capable of running as planned, including due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter, which corrupt or affect the administration security, fairness or integrity or proper conduct of this promotion, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, and, subject to any written directions given by the Queensland Police Service, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the promotion.

In the case of the intervention of any outside agent or event which naturally changes the result or prevents or hinders its determination, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, strikes; the promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the event and recommence it from the start on the same conditions subject to State Regulation.
