## Competition guidelines and entry requirements:

- All entrants must be in grades three to six at a Logan school and must have their parent or guardian's permission.
- The submission must be completed on an A4 piece of paper or cardboard from the above template location.
- The submission must be completed by the child entering the competition
- The submission must be an original idea and not a copy
- The submission must be scanned and emailed prior to 5pm on August 12, 2021. All submissions after this time will not be included in this competition.
- Your email must provide the entrant's **full name, school and grade as well as their parent/guardian's name, address and mobile number**. The submission will be judged by a panel of three members and all participants are to accept this panel's decision.
- All entrants and their parent(s)/guardian(s) entering this competition must consent to the submission being used in the promotion of road safety messaging including being displayed at the *Logan Art Centre* for public viewing and on various social media platforms.
- All entrants and their parent(s)/guardian(s) entering this competition consent to having their photo taken with the Logan City Council Mayor for publication to promote Queensland Road Safety Week and the competition.
- Entrants are asked to include their name, grade and school on the bottom right-hand-corner of the submission to be considered.
